

Editing tools



This toolbar will show when text can be inserted or edited on most pages. Most of these tools are common to other word-processing applications. Below are explanations to others that are important.

Add Media: Click this to insert an image or document into the page from the media library.

Paragraph (Font): Drop this list of fonts to select a font to use for the text being entered. One problem with this is that the font as shown while editing is usually very different than that shown in the working website. To check what a font will look like in the finished site, click on the *Preview* button on the right side of the page.



Insert a link: This is used to insert a link (such as that at the top of this picture) to another page. When a user clicks on such a link, the website will move immediately to the page it represents.



Horizontal line: Can be used to insert a horizontal line under a section of text.



Table: Used to insert or edit a table of columns and rows. Is useful to organise text neatly. Tables have been used many times in this website such as for the pennant selections; the main part of the member area; the life member list etc. Tables can be of any number of columns and rows and be visible or invisible.



Toolbar Toggle: If the second line of the toolbar is not showing, click this tool.

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Add Media Option - Insert a document or image into a page

1. Click in the page where you want to insert the image or document
2. Click *Add Media*. You will be taken to the media library. Navigate to the folder which contains the image or document you wish to insert.
3. Select the item to be inserted.
4. Click *Insert into page* at the bottom right of the screen.
5. If it is an image, then it will be displayed. Click the image to display its outline and corner handles. You can change its size by dragging the corners, or use other functions displayed above the image.
6. If it is a document, a link to that document will be inserted into the page.

Another way to add a link to a document or image is:

1. While in the media library, right-click the item, then select *Copy URL*.
2. Now click the X in the top right to return to the page you are working on.
3. Enter some text describing the link
4. Highlight the text

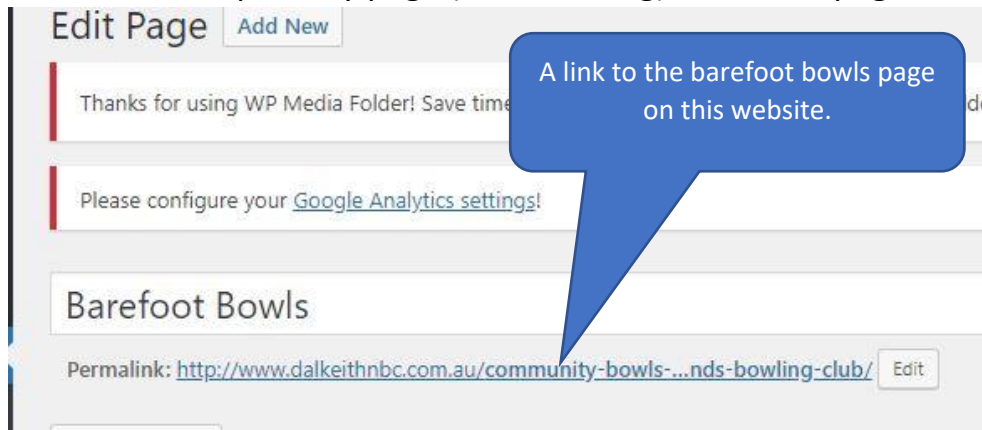
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Insert a link to another page

Use this tool to enter a link to another page on this or other website.

1. You will need the target web address. Addresses on this website can be found at the top of any page (while editing) under the page title.

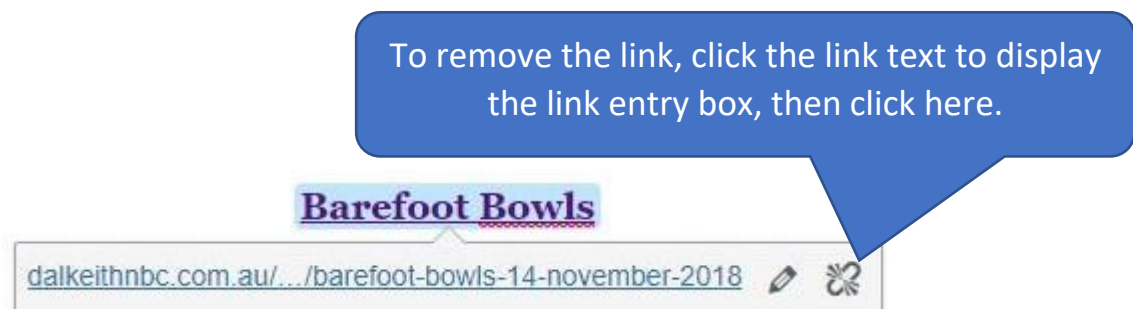


To copy the link, Hover your mouse over it and right-click, then select “Copy link address”. It is a good idea to paste the copied link into Notepad or another text editor, so you don’t lose it.

2. To insert a link to this page in another page, first go the other page, then write some link text, then highlight all of the entered text, then click on the link icon shown above. The link entry space will show.

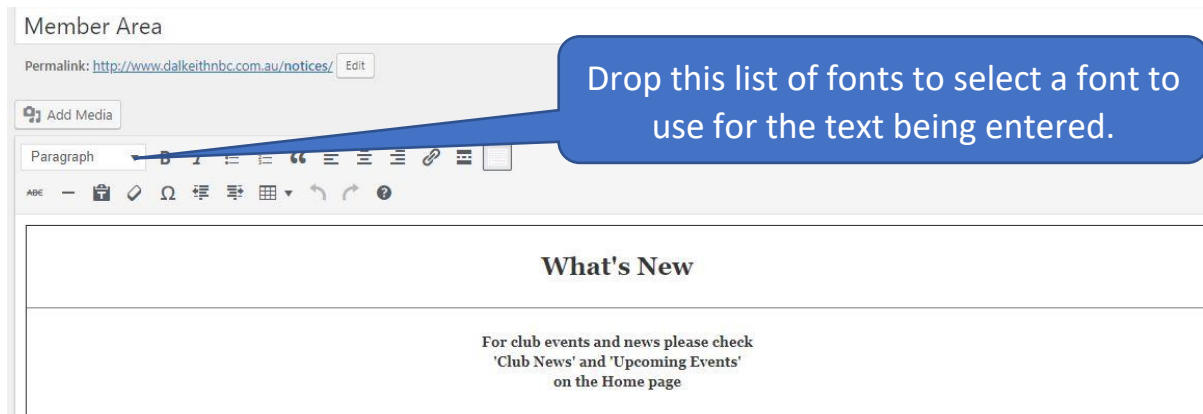


Just click anywhere outside the entry box to make it invisible. The link should now be purple with an underline.



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Selecting a font



One problem with font selection is that the font as shown while editing is usually very different than that shown in the working website. To check what a

font will look like in the finished site, click on the *Preview* button on the right side of the page.

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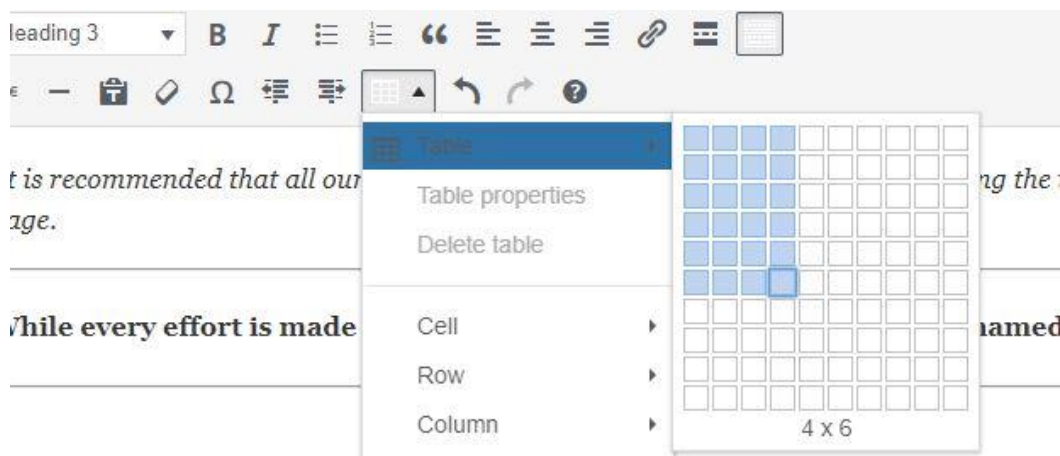


Table Tool: Used to insert or edit a table of columns and rows. Is useful to organise text neatly. Create a table

Click and hold on the table tool, then move your mouse onto Table then to the right and down until the correct number of rows and columns are highlighted. Then click to insert the table into the text area.

Once an empty table has been created, explore the options under the table tool to see the effect on the table. There are options for merging cells, inserting new columns or rows, changing the column width, and many others.
