Our first summer with just the two greens staff has been satisfactory, despite some problems created by an unusual number of ants invading a couple of greens.


Also the success of the pennant teams (while a credit to the players and selectors) together with

Selection 2007/2008



Club Finances

As you are aware the Club Treasurer, Bill Robertson, resigned early this year and I became Acting Treasurer. I thank most sincerely, Martin Adams, Geoff Sansom (Treasurer Elect), John Bridge and Brian Burton for their work in finalising this years accounts and dealing with the day to day transactions. It has been a great effort.

The results for the year show a loss of \$31,999 after charging \$15,273 in Depreciation.

There were a number of major Repairs and Maintenance carried out during the year, the total of which amounted to \$14,314. The Club House both internally and externally are in pretty good shape and should not require a lot of maintenance in the coming year.
