Can it get any better than this year? What an outstanding year all round, **3 pennants, 3 promotions**, Bowls WA Award for Membership. 1 Blue on Thursdays - to 1 Gold on Saturdays and 4th to 3rd on Saturdays. Our 3rd on Thursdays missed the pennant by 6 shots! Congratulations to our selectors lead by David Hyde, and all the players who supported pennants. Our ladies just missed promotion to 1st division.

Our season started with a record 60 teams entered in the John Stewart Spring 4's - an outstanding carnival.

Membership in 2001 increased by 75 new men and ladies. So far in 2002 we already have 64 new members proving the great success of our \$50 restricted membership, who are capitated to allow them to bowl 7 days a week but not play organised bowls. The men have capitated a record 301 members for 2001-2002. The ladies have capitated 100.

Corporate bowls have been well organised by Fred House with 20 groups bringing 820 people onto our greens. This not only introduces new people to bowls but also is a great help to the bar.

A special thanks to Libby who has just left for Europe. Treasurer John Bridge keeps a close watch on our finances which show a small cash surplus of \$4000. Our ladies have been a great support this year with a lot of catering and general support throughout the club's activities. It is most encouraging to see the ladies nearly double in number during the last twelve months. Some of our men are assisting the ladies coach cope with the influx of new members, which is good for the club.

Looking Ahead

The fantastic results of our two divisions both on Thursday and Saturdays, has been made possible mainly to the consistency of the teams put forward each week. 



