- ^{3.} When a measure is taking place, those not directly involved must keep well away. If umpire is called players should retire to the bank.
- ⁴. When a player is near the point of delivery, all players on that rink must be still, quiet and two metres from the mat.
- 5. Bowls must never be dropped onto the green.
